

# Basic amenities at Auric to be completed by Dec

₹2,000 cr of govt spent till today ■ Auric Hall to be ready in 7 months

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The much-talked-about and much-awaited Aurangabad Industrial City (Auric) will be provided with 95 per cent basic amenities by December-end this year.

Also, the work of the five-storey Auric Hall has been 60 per cent complete and it is expected to be ready by October.

The State Government has spent a whopping Rs 2,000 crore on the basic amenities at Shendra and Bidkin DMIC. Now, all Marathwada's attention is drawn towards Auric in Shendra.

Aurangabad Industrial Township Ltd (AITL) joint managing director Gajanan Patil, at a media conference, said Auric work is under progress.

"The basic amenities work is nearly 60-70 per cent complete. This

## 5 MNCs to invest in Auric

Five multi-national companies will invest in Auric. Joint MD of AITL Gajanan Patil said Korea's Hyosung, a textile industry, is the first anchor project to have bought 100 acres of land in Auric. In the first phase, the company is going to invest Rs 3,500 crore and the actual work of the company will start by May 2019.

A dialysis machinery manufacturing company of China has bought 10 acres of land and the company is to invest Rs 110 crore. Also, a company in construction field in China is going to invest Rs 150. Its project will come up on 10 acres. Other than this, some Korean and Japanese companies are also interested to invest in Auric.

includes roads, footpaths, street lights, sewage system, water supply pipeline, sub-stations for power supply, underground electrical cable, fire safety and fire fighting system. Tarring of 60 metre and 45 metre roads is 95 per cent complete in Auric and these works will be finished by

June. There are roads, including 30 metre, 18 and 12 metre, in Auric. A total road length constructed till today is 63 km. Fire fighting pumps have been installed in all over the city. Two big railway overbridges at Karmad and Satana will be thrown open for traffic after December.

## Affordable houses for common man

Residential locality will be constructed in Auric. In this



locality, developers will construct houses which will be affordable to common man. For this, 15 acres of land is reserved. There will be 600 sq ft flat in this residential area. Also, there will be

16 bungalows and 11 open industrial plots and two commercial plots.

Later, Satana railway overbridge will be connected to Samruddhi Expressway. Also, 16 other small flyovers work is in final phase. The work of installation of five sub-stations for power supply will be done. Out of which two sub-stations work is under progress. Optical fibre network is also under

progress and telecom companies are given the work on a lease."

The government has decided to invest Rs 11,000 crore in DMIC, out of which Rs 3,000 crore for land acquisition while Rs 8,000 crore for basic amenities. Out of which, Rs 2,000 crore have been spent on basic amenities, Patil said.
